## How Medicaid Can Help Enrollees Quit Smoking

The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) released an <u>informational bulletin</u> with strategies that states have used to improve delivery of tobacco cessation services to beneficiaries of Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP). States are required to cover certain services for certain groups. For example, counseling and pharmacotherapy for enrollees who are pregnant must be covered. Coverage for other services, such as over-the-counter medications, is optional. All recommended tobacco cessation services – including individual, group and telephone counseling, and all <u>seven FDA-approved cessation medications</u> – are Medicaid or CHIP- coverable services, and the bulletin provides resources and strategies states can use to increase quit rates. Medicaid is <u>an important source of health coverage</u> in rural areas, where <u>smoking rates are often higher</u> than in urban areas.

# Information Session on CMS Interoperability and Prior Authorization Final Rule

In January, the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) released a final rule <u>to</u> <u>enhance access to health information</u> and streamline prior authorization processes for medical items and services. CMS's Office of Burden Reduction & Health Informatics is hosting an online session on March 26 at Noon CT to educate patients, providers, and administrative, health IT, and government affairs professionals about the provisions in the final rule and how it builds on current CMS interoperability policies. Questions can be submitted beforehand via the <u>registration form</u>. If you register and receive a message that the event is full, you will receive an email after the event with a link to both a recording and transcript of the presentation. The use of various electronic exchange methods among hospitals and physicians has increased in recent years, but <u>use among small and rural hospitals is lower</u> than that of other hospitals.
