New Funding for Rural Communities Opioid Response Program

This week, HRSA announced a funding opportunity that is part of the agency's rural-specific response to the opioid epidemic. RCORP –Impact kicks off a new rural opioid treatment and recovery initiative under the umbrella of RCORP, which will focus on establishing new comprehensive substance use disorder treatment and recovery services in rural communities. The program is intended to grow and strengthen a rural network of integrated care for substance use disorder with a requirement that clinical services be coordinated with social support that may include housing assistance, food access, and employment training

Call for Applications: 2024 Million Hearts® Hypertension Control Challenge

The U.S. Department of Agriculture (USDA) will invest approximately \$60 million in funding to digitally connect remote parts of the country to education, training, and health care resources.

The Million Hearts® Hypertension Control Challenge identifies clinicians and practices that have demonstrated exceptional achievements in working with their patients to control hypertension. This year, the Challenge will be recognizing those who achieved blood pressure control (blood pressure readings below 140 mm Hg/90 mm Hg) among 80% of their population ages 18–85 years who have hypertension.
